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A Constitutional Love Affair

Why do Americans, particularly Christians, have such a love affair with the United States Constitution in thinking it is a Christian document? It is not. The founding fathers greatest sin in forming the U.S. Constitution is the **omission** of God Almighty and his Son our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ that is nowhere found in the Document.

Some of the originators of the U.S. Constitution, were not Christian but deists. Is it because we have been told repeatedly that The U.S. Constitution is one of the most important documents ever written by man, because it was based upon Biblical principles and is a great Christian document? Or because the victors in the culture war wrote our history the way they wanted us to perceive it? Well, sorry to expose this, but it is not a Christian document.

Jefferson, whose hands are all over the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution was a deist influenced by the reason centered views of the Enlightenment. He actually wrote a condensed version of the bible **eliminating** many of the references to miracles and supernatural works **including the resurrection of Christ**. This work, commonly referred to as the Jefferson Bible, was titled “The Life and Morals of Jesus of Nazareth”. Jefferson was a materialist and as such he held to a “natural religion” **and he saw Jesus as a great moral teacher but did not view him as the son of God**.

Others who have been considered deists include George Washington, Benjamin Franklin, Ethan Allen, Thomas Paine, and John Adams. Some of these are disputed and there are others who have clearly been influenced in their thoughts by “deism”.

Deist: A religious belief holding that God created the universe and established rationally comprehensible moral and natural laws but does not intervene in human affairs through

miracles or supernatural revelation.

Most Americans believe what they have been taught about the founding of our government and are content to leave it at that.

The first one to plead his cause seems right, until his neighbor comes and examines him. (Proverbs 18:17, NKJV)

Most Christians are thrilled to think our nation's founding document was written by Christians and inspired by the Bible, and they don't want to be told otherwise. Yes there were Christians who were also there during the formation of the Constitution, but they were influence by the deist who were present there.

I hope to motivate you to think about the Constitution, a document few Americans have read and to which fewer still have given any serious thought, *especially from a Biblical paradigm*. (Paradigm: A set of assumptions, concepts, values, and practices that constitutes a way of viewing reality for the community that shares them, especially in an intellectual discipline.) More importantly, I hope to inspire you to study God's law and esteem it as did the Psalmist, who declared his love for the law seven times in Psalm 119. I also hope to create a vision for His kingdom *here on earth* as it is in heaven. Christians **had the responsibility** to uphold Biblical principles in *every* aspect of life – including government. **They did not.** We will never achieve a nation that honors the God of the Bible by promoting the Constitution. Why? Because of the greatest sin of the framers of the Constitution and their **omission** of God and His Son Jesus Christ. The Constitution is not the Biblically compatible document we have been told it is. It actually conflicts with Christianity and is hostile to both God's sovereignty and morality. How I can say this, especially when so many sources appear to authenticate the Constitution as a document created by Christian men? Is the Constitution Biblically compatible? Have you ever studied its contents and compared them to that of the Scriptures? I have, and I was astounded by what I found. How can a document be Biblical that promotes the **will of the people, by the people and for the people over God's will and His Lordship over his people?** How can such a document be the answer to America's growing horrible current national crises?

Is the U.S. Constitution a Christian Document? Answer: No

History doesn't lie. Look at America before and since the ratification of the Constitution. **Before 1788, America was principally Christian.** Since 1788, America has become progressively less Christian in every respect. This alone speaks volumes about the document drafted in 1787 in Philadelphia.

Because the kingdom of Yahweh (*Yahweh: The name for God*) exists and advances by His laws, it was these same present day thinking, that hindered others from entering and the kingdom or from prospering. The commandments of men, "By the people and for the people" – with no mention of Jesus Christ.) is preventing the kingdom from being fully realized today.

Everything good and noble about America can be traced back to the early 1600s, when many of the original colonies were governed by the laws of God. Everything wrong about America today can be traced back to 1789 when the States ratified the Constitution with it's omission of God. **This, of course, runs contrary to everything we've been told about the Constitution for more than 220 years. But a lie is still a lie regardless**

how often it's told.

It is possible for an idol to become so entrenched in the fabric of society that even the people of God with their Judeo-Christian heritage fail to recognize it for what it is and to take steps to get rid of it. Our modern idols are not always easy to detect. They often take the shape of ideas and institutions woven into the warp and woof of our culture.

This document, which acknowledges no one true God, protects other religion's idolatry equally with Christianity as is built into the Constitution's 1st amendment, and puts the servants of Satan, other religions, on the same footing with Christianity. Preferring the doctrines of the Constitution to those of the Bible – Preferring George Washington over Moses, and Jefferson over King David. The mass of godless professors scoff at God's legislation, embodied in the Mosaic institutions.... There never was a government that has exercised so rapid and fatal an influence over the doctrines, the discipline, and the whole character of the Church, as the God-rejecting Constitution of the United States as written.

If God's kingdom is ever to be fully realized here on earth, Americans must recognize and repent of their national idolatry – their love affair with the Godless, Christless, humanistic, and polytheistic promoting Constitution. **To identify the Constitution in such a fashion may initially sound unpatriotic and perhaps even treasonous. How can I make such a statement? Because most Christians have yet to identify the Constitution as one of the prime contributors to America's problems, the Biblical solution has escaped them. Henry David Thoreau wrote, "There are a thousand hacking at the branches of evil to one who is striking at the root."

If, someday, we have enough Christians left to correct the omission of God in our early two documents, our blessing and protection from God Almighty will continue to leave us and our Nation is doomed and the Islamist could have their flag over the White House as we continue to see our freedoms leave America.
